The Chapel seats 1000
 The Chancel walls are faced with marble, having stained glass in the windows.
 Ministers and Stewards vestries and lavatory.
 The windows are of Cathedral tinted glass in combination with stained glass.
 The fittings are of deal, cushioned throughout, umbrella stands provided to alternate seats.
 Size of Chapel, interior, 95-ft. by 47-ft. height 50-ft.
 Ditto exterior, including vestries and entrances 141-ft. by 53-ft., height 80-ft.
 The staircase towers 75-ft. high.
 The central tower 150-ft. high.
 The walls are executed in Kentish Rag, Bath, Red Mansfield, & Portland Stones being also introduced.

 School-room [adapted for a Lecture Hall] 50-ft. by 45-ft. 14-ft. high.
 Infants' room 24-ft. by 17-ft.
